INTENT TO APPLY FOR

2010 LAND & WATER CONSERVATION FUND GRANT

As part of the grant requirements for the 2010 Land & Water Conservation Fund “LWCF”, which is offered through the South Carolina Department of Parks, Recreation, and Tourism, the City of Cayce will hold a public input session scheduled for Thursday, February 25, 2010 at 5:30 PM at the City Hall Complex, Council Chambers, located at 1800 12th Street Extension.

As part of the City’s overall desire to create a park system of trails and support services, we propose additional trails (Riverwalk Expansion – Trails – Phase III) to link from the existing Riverwalk Park (which is part of the overall Three Rivers Greenway Project) through designated right-of-way and run along the riverfront stretching from south of the City Water Plant then eventually ending at the Thomas Newman Boat Landing. This extension of trails, approximately ½ mile, would be constructed to meet the same standards as the existing Riverwalk Park. The project also includes a parking area.

The general public and other interested parties are encouraged to attend this public input session. Questions regarding the City’s intent to apply for this grant and/or review of documents relating to the grant are available for public inspection in the office of the Grants Coordinator, The City of Cayce.
