Dear Citizens of Cayce:

The City of Cayce has recently experienced an elevated number of vehicle and residential break-ins. The Cayce Public Safety Officers have been vigilant and apprehended several suspects who were charged with the commission of these break-ins. The break-ins appear to be occurring at random times and in different areas of the city. Almost all of the vehicle break-ins have been to vehicles that had valuables visible from outside of the vehicle i.e. brief case, gym bags, GPS or other container or cases. On a limited basis, expensive radios systems have been targeted. Several vehicles and residences have been entered via unlocked doors. I encourage you to secure all items inside your vehicles and please lock all doors. Additionally, security lights are a deterrent to these types of crimes.
