



Lexington County Electronics Recycling Program



Effective July 1, 2011, state law requires S.C. residents to recycle computers, computer monitors, televisions and printers.

Electronic scrap (e-scrap) is accepted for recycling from residents and businesses at the Edmund C&D Landfill. There is no charge for residents however businesses will be charged a fee of \$39.45 per ton (\$0.02 per pound) for e-scrap material brought to the landfill for recycling. A maximum of 5 electronic pieces will be accepted per household/business per visit at the landfill.

A computer set (monitor, CPU, keyboard and mouse) will count as one piece. A small box or bag of rechargeable batteries, cell phones and telephones will also count as one piece. Televisions, microwaves, copiers, printers, etc. will each be considered one piece.

Lexington County Solid Waste Management will also hold periodic one-day e-scrap recycling events around the country. The following electronics are accepted:

- Computers – CPUs and laptops, mainframes, peripherals
- Monitors – CRTs and flat screens
- Telephones, cell phones and telephone systems
- Fax machines and central office equipment
- Printer and copiers
- Televisions
- Microwaves
- Banking and financial equipment
- Medical equipment
- Rechargeable batteries
- Electronic circuit boards and components
- Stereo equipment, games and PDAs

When dropping off your electronics at the Edmund C&D Landfill, residents and businesses will be directed to the appropriate drop-off location. Please bring extra help to unload any large items. The electronics should be stacked neatly or placed inside the appropriate gaylord box.
