

Taylor Road Railroad Crossing to reopen; three other crossings to close

The City of Cayce anticipates reopening the Taylor Road railroad crossing in mid-October, allowing access from Taylor Road to Twelfth Street and giving more Cayce residents a direct route to I-77. The move will also allow local police and fire units to respond more quickly to service calls to the majority of Cayce residents.

The reopening requires the city to permanently close three other at-grade crossings that are currently underused. The crossings to be closed include Godley Street under the Twelfth Street overpass, Taylor Street at Foreman Street, and Taylor Street at State Street.

The city anticipates the three crossings will be closed beginning the last week of September, prior to the reopening of the Taylor Road crossing. The city wants to raise awareness of the sequence of closings and the reopening of the Taylor Road crossing to lessen confusion among residents.

Aside from making travel and the delivery of essential services easier, the reopening of the Taylor Road crossing will also create direct access to the Busbee Creative Arts Academy on Bulldog Lane from residential areas.
