

General Information on the City of Cayce Ordinance Regulating Smoking in Places of Employment

- When:** The ordinance takes effect June 1, 2010.
- Applies to:** All enclosed places of employment (all indoor workplaces and all enclosed work spaces as defined) in the City of Cayce (including restaurants and bars meeting that description) and areas within ten feet of the entrance or exit of such places
- Does not apply to:** Private residences
Hotel and motel rooms designated as smoking rooms
Retail tobacco stores as defined
Private clubs with no employees (except during public events)
- Compliance:** Area businesses must display “No Smoking” signs with the international “No Smoking” symbol at the main entrance to their building
- Penalty:** Each violation is punishable by a fine of \$25. The fine can be assessed against the individual who violated the ordinance or against the business in which a violation took place. Repeated violations may subject a business to suspension or revocation of its occupancy permit or business license.
