Cayce Public Safety Foundation Board of Directors Meeting Minutes March 7, 2022

Call to Order: Pamme Eades called the meeting to order at 545 PM

Present: Kay Hutchinson, Pamme Eades, Rebecca Lorick, James Crosland, Mayor Pro Tem Skip Jenkins, PD Chief Cowan, FD Chief Bullard, Russ Shumard, April Blake, Karen Sanders, Regina Lemmon-Bush (via Zoom).

Approval of Minutes: A motion to approve the January 25, 2022 minutes was made by April Blake, was 2nd by Rebecca Lorick and unanimously approved by the board. FD Chief Bullard pointed out an error in the minutes regarding the approval for the purchase of "Go-Pro" cameras for the FD (3 cameras not 2).

New Business "Steel Paws"

Chief Cowan introduced Ashley from Steel Hands Brewing. She presented and discussed a special event titled "Steel Paws" which will take place at Steel Hands on Saturday April 30, 2022 (May 7th makeup date). This event would benefit K-9 units at Cayce PD as well as RCSO and LCSO (K-9 demos, LE patrol car static displays, auctions etc). Steel Hands would be promoting the event via social media and press release. Sponsorship opportunities of various monetary levels will be available for purchase.

Chief Cowan pointed out the potential of generating \$100,000 in proceeds with a majority of the proceeds going to the Cayce PSF. RCSO foundation and LCSO foundation would benefit as the Cayce PD K-9 unit participates and trains regularly with the other named agencies. Another portion of proceeds would go to alcohol abuse and education.

Chief Cowan pointed out assistance would be needed from the board to help and volunteer at the event.
