Ms. Corder advised that the County Election Commission would meet on Thursday, November 9 at 9:00 am to certify the results of the General Election. As stated in the City's ordinance, Cayce's Municipal Election Commission would certify the results of the City's election.

Ms. Corder advised that commissioners would meet a Vella's at 11:00 am for lunch. She provided each Commissioner with a name badge and a brochure containing information on what candidates and/or their poll workers can and cannot do on the day of the election at or near precincts.

Ms. Corder stressed that the Commissioners are there to observe the voting process being handled by the County and if they see anything that should be addressed, they are to report that information to the Lexington County Poll Manager at the precinct. Ms. Corder stated she would also be available to the Commissioners on Election Day from 7am to 7pm and not to hesitate to call if she is needed.
