

## **City Fiscal Year (FY) 22-23 Budget** July 1, 2022 - June 30, 2023

The City of Cayce prides itself on being diligent and transparent when using public funds for the operations of the City. Further, we strive to provide the best services with very little impact to our citizens. Similar to many neighboring cities and due to the increase in cost of living, the proposed FY23 budget includes a 4.37 millage adjustment to local property taxes -this equates to \$1.45 a month for every \$100,000 in assessed home value. In being good stewards of tax payer money, the City has not increased any fees or taxes for several years, including through the pandemic period.


## **General Fund Revenue**
