A Special Council Meeting was held this afternoon at 5:00 p.m. in Council Chambers. Those present included Mayor Pro-Tem James Jenkins, Council Members Tara Almond, Phil Carter and Eva Corley, City Manager Rebecca Vance, Assistant City Manager Shaun Greenwood, Municipal Clerk Mendy Corder and City Treasurer Garry Huddle. Mayor Partin was out of town at a conference. Mayor Pro-Tem Jenkins asked if members of the press and the public were duly notified of the meeting in accordance with the FOIA. Ms. Corder confirmed they were notified.

Call to Order

A. Discussion and Approval of Resolution Declaring the Elections to be Open and Advising Deadline for Write-In Candidates

Ms. Vance stated Council approval is needed for a Resolution to declare the election open for filing and advising the deadline for filing for write-in candidates. She stated that the City Attorney suggested that a Resolution be approved to declare the election open for filing. In addition, by State Law, it is the City's responsibility to notify write-in candidates the deadline for filing. Books are open for filing beginning August 1, 2016 at noon and remain open during regular business hours until noon August 15, 2016. Citizens desiring to be a candidate must file a Statement of Candidacy at the Lexington County Election Commission and pay the appropriate fee of \$50. Any declaration to be a write-in candidate must be submitted in writing to the Lexington County Election Commission by noon August 29, 2016.

Council Member Almond made a motion to approve a Resolution declaring the election open for filing and advising the deadline for filing for write-in candidates. Council Member Corley seconded the motion which was unanimously approved by roll call vote.



Financial Participation Agreement & Contract

WHEREAS, on April 4, 2014, the parties hereto entered into an Agreement <u>FPA-17-14</u> to design and install ADA compliant sidewalks, catch basins and detectable warning surfaces along Julius Felder Street (S-630); and

WHEREAS, the total project costs under the original Agreement were estimated at One Hundred Eighty-Nine Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Seven <u>\$189,297.00</u> Dollars; and

WHEREAS, on May 22, 2014, the Participant remitted funds in the amount of Forty-Four Thousand Two Hundred Ninety-Seven \$44,297.00 Dollars to the SCDOT under the original Agreement shown as Attachment 1;

WHEREAS, the Participant has estimated that the revised total project cost is Six Hundred Five Thousand Seven Hundred Thirty-Three Dollars Seventy-Five Cents \$605,733.75; and

WHEREAS, on October 22, 2015, the PARTICIPANT requested an additional Three Hundred Twenty-Three Thousand Five Hundred Eighty-Nine Dollars Twelve Cents \$323,589.12 in Columbia Area Transportation Study Federal Transportation Alternatives Funds (hereinafter COATS) approved the request. See Attachment 2; and

WHEREAS, at the Participant's request, the SCDOT has agreed to modify the original Agreement to revise the Scope and the Funding Section to reflect additional scope and funds; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the several promises to be faithfully performed by the parties as set forth herein, the SCDOT and the Participant do hereby agree as follows:

I. DESCRIPTION

Design and install ADA compliant sidewalk from the corner of Maple Street along Julius Felder Street to the corner of Summerland Drive and continue down Julius Felder Street to the corner of Hemlock Street. Will include any clearing/grading/excavating needed. Silt fencing during construction, catch basins, and detectable warning surfaces. Power/FOG boxes will be moved and inlet filters installed where needed.

- II. FUNDING is being modified to reflect the following:
- a. The Participant estimates the total cost for the project to be \$605,733.75.
- b. The SCDOT's maximum funding for the project is \$468,589.12. SCDOT Commission approved the additional funds on October 22, 2015.
- c. The Participant is responsible for 100% of the cost of the project excluding SCDOT's maximum funding as identified in "b" directly above.

ISSUE

Council approval is needed for the Second Reading of an Ordinance amending Section 4-11 of the Cayce City Code to regulate drinking in public within the City limits.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

A review of the City Code recently revealed some technical issues that needed to be resolved in regards to alcohol consumption at events and festivals. Section 4-11 needs to be amended to ensure there are no conflicts with consuming alcohol at outdoor festivals and events. The wording in the current ordinance would technically not allow for the consumption of alcohol outside of a building or structure. The Public Safety Director and City Attorney have reviewed the suggested amendment and believe the changes will serve the best interests of the City and the public.

Additionally, language was removed that would not allow alcohol from being consumed at establishments where the alcohol was produced. This in effect places significant burden on certain businesses like craft breweries.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends Council approve Second Reading of an Ordinance amending Section 4-11 of the Cayce City Code to regulate drinking in public within the City limits.

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is necessary and proper for the security, general welfare and convenience of the City and to preserve safety, health, order and good government in the City, that the City amend the current wording of its Code in Section 4-11 to provide for amended regulations pertaining to drinking in public,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Cayce, in Council, duly assembled, that Section 4-11 ("Drinking in Public") of the City of Cayce General Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sec. 4-11. - Drinking in public.

(a)

Except as allowed by Section 4-13, it shall be unlawful for any person to have in their possession any beer, wine, or alcoholic beverage in an open container, or in any container with a broken seal, in any public place within the corporate limits of the City of Cayce, except as provided herein below.

(b)

For the purposes of this section the term "public place" shall be defined as:

(1)

Any real property owned by any federal, state, county, or municipal government or any agency thereof; and

(2)

Any real property, regardless of ownership, which is open to members of the public, save and except real property where drinking is allowed pursuant to a permit or license from the State of South Carolina.

(c)

The prohibition provided in subsection (a) above, shall not be applicable to:

(1)

Any areas designated by city council as a special events area to include, but
not limited to, any public park, street sidewalk or any portion thereof, for
limited durations, and designated as the site of a public festival or other
special event; or

(2)
Any areas as designated in a special event or temporary use permit issued by the city.

Sec. 4-11. - Drinking in public.

Except as allowed by section 4-13, it shall be unlawful for any person within the city to:

(1)

Publicly engage in the drinking of alcoholic liquors, beer, ale, porter, wine or any other similar malt or fermented beverage, except within the business structure, house or building so licensed to sell such product for on-premises consumption.

(2)

Engage in the drinking of alcoholic liquor, beer, ale, porter, wine or any other similar malt or fermented beverage upon any premises upon which an athletic contest or amusement contest is being conducted.

(3)

Drink alcoholic liquors, beer, ale, porter, wine or any other similar malt or fermented beverage on the premises of any retail, wholesale or manufacturing alcoholic liquor business or business establishment.

(a)

Except as allowed by Section 4-13, it shall be unlawful for any person to have in their possession any beer, wine, or alcoholic beverage in an open container, or in any container with a broken seal, in any public place within the corporate limits of the City of Cayce, except as provided herein below.

For the purposes of this section the term "public place" shall be defined as:

<u>(1)</u>

ISSUE

Second Reading of Ordinance to annex properties located at 1416 Alex Street (TMS#005750-09-004), 1418 Alex Street (TMS#005750-09-005) and a property located on Naples Avenue (TMS#005750-09-015), in conjunction with an RS-4 zoning designation.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION

Council approval is needed for the Second Reading of an Ordinance to annex .70 acres of land located at 1416 Alex Street (TMS#005750-09-004), 1418 Alex Street (TMS#005750-09-005), and a property located at Naples Avenue (TMS#005750-09-015), Lexington County. The recommended zoning is RS-4 (Single Family, Small Lots).

The properties were purchased by the City in hopes to use the land for a new water tower and they will be consolidated with the successful annexation of the properties.

The properties are currently under Lexington County jurisdiction and contiguous to one parcel under the City's jurisdiction.

The recommended zoning for the property is RS-4 (Single Family, Small Lots) which would be consistent with the contiguous zoning of the surrounding area. Water supply systems is a permitted use in the RS-4 zoning district.

The Planning Commission considered the request for annexation at its regular meeting on May 16, 2016. A public hearing was held at the meeting for public input. One member of the public was present to inquire about the annexation request.

The Planning Commission unanimously recommended Council approve the requested annexation and RS-4 zoning designation.

RECOMMENDATION

The Planning Commission recommends Council approve the Second Reading of an Ordinance to annex properties located at 1416 Alex Street (TMS#005750-09-004), 1418 Alex Street (TMS#005750-09-005) and a property located on Naples Avenue (TMS#005750-09-015), in conjunction with an RS-4 zoning designation.






